Over the past three years, many of these projects have been completed (see below) and it's now time to create a

new PRCR Master Plan to ensure our park facilities meet the needs of our citizens.

## Plastic Bags are a Recycling No-No

Plastic bags and bagged recyclables are the #1 contaminant in recycling! Plastic bags can tangle sorting equipment causing it to jam and break. When this happens, the Recycling Center has to shut down to remove the bags by climbing into sorting machines and untangling plastic bags that have wrapped around moving parts. The contamination cost is significant in terms on money and time.



You can do your part to help with this problem! Make sure recyclables are emptied of their contents, free of food and liquids, and place them directly in the recycle cart. Remember to keep plastic bags out of your recycle cart! Plastic bags can be returned to grocery stores for proper recycling.

### Please DO recycle:

- Paper such as newspapers, magazines, junk mail, printed paper, office paper, catalog and telephone books
- Cardboard & Boxboard
- Metal, glass, or plastic bottles, jars, cans and jugs

### Please DO NOT recycle:

- Loose plastic bags or recyclables in plastic bags
- Pizza boxes or plastic containers with an oily residue (yogurt or butter tubs)
- Styrofoam
