The grand opening for Hilltop Needmore Town Park & Preserve will be Saturday, February 8th at 2:30 PM at 4621 Shady Greens Drive. The park consists of 143 acres with 5 miles of paved greenway trails. Parking will be available at 4621 Shady Greens Drive.

Yard Debris Reminder:

The Town requires yard debris to be placed in a bag (any type bag is acceptable) or a 20 gallon rigid tote not to exceed 40 pounds. The 20 gallon tote requirement helps to ensure that the container will not weigh more than 40 lbs. We cannot pick up containers weighing more than 40 lbs.

A member of the Police Department may be requested at no cost to perform a residential or business security survey to recommend methods to enhance security to include suggestions about trimming shrubbery, adding lighting, or enhancing locking mechanisms. 

Temporary Changes to Drinking Water in March

Each year during the month of March, the Town's water suppliers including Harnett County, Johnston County and the City of Raleigh temporarily change their water treatment process by suspending the use of ammonia. This disinfection process is a state-mandated practice to ensure safe drinking water. Fuquay-Varina customers who use kidney dialysis machines and have fish aquariums should be aware that water may contain chlorine, ammonia or a mixture of the two from Feb. 25-April 5, 2020. The Town will also conduct flushing of the distribution system during this time. Customers may experience a slight discoloration of their drinking water.
