Stormwater Grant

On February 21, the State Water Infrastructure Authority awarded the Town \$400,000 in Local Assistance for Stormwater Infrastructure Investments (LASII) funding. LASII funding is new funding with no local match requirements that provides grants for local governments in the form of reimbursement for projects that will improve infrastructure for controlling stormwater quantity/quality.

The Town submitted the LASII grant application to develop and implement a Stormwater Utility following completion of a Stormwater Asset Inventory, Capital Improvement Program Development, a Stormwater Utility Feasibility Study, and a Stormwater Utility Implementation Plan. Forming a stormwater utility fee creates a dedicated revenue source that can be used to support long-term planning for the control of stormwater runoff that benefits both the community's functionality and the surrounding environment.
